### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to negligent and reckless driving.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 24 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding, after
- 2 subsection (2)(a) the following new subsection:-
- 3 (2)(b) Whoever upon any way or in any place to which the public has a right of access, or
- 4 any place to which members of the public have access as invitees or licensees, operates a motor
- 5 vehicle recklessly, or operates such a vehicle negligently, where such operation results in serious
- 6 bodily injury or death, shall be punished by confinement to a state prison for no more than ten
- years, and by a loss of their license to operate motor vehicles for a minimum of five years after
- 8 such confinement.
