**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act maintaining protective orders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (h) of section 3 of chapter 209A, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- Orders restricting or preventing contact with
3 the plaintiff’s child or children shall survive the death of the plaintiff until such orders are
4 vacated by the court or until the orders expires.
