### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to Good Samaritans"; liability during a public health emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 13 of Chapter 258C is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the

2 following:- No person who, in good faith, during a declared public health emergency donates

3 food or other items shall be liable in a civil suit for damages as a result of any acts or omissions

4 in providing or obtaining, or attempting to provide or obtain, such assistance unless such acts or

5 omissions constitute willful, wanton or reckless conduct.
