An Act supporting student mental health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 37R the following section:-

3 Section 37S. (a) Commencing August 1, 2022, a public school, including a charter  
4 school, that serves students in any of grades 7 to 12, inclusive, that issues student identification  
5 cards shall include on the student identification cards the telephone number for the National  
6 Suicide Prevention Lifeline, Crisis Text Line, and the school’s campus police or security  
7 telephone number or, if the school does not have a campus police or security telephone number,  
8 the local nonemergency telephone number.

9 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if, as of August 1, 2023, a school subject to the  
10 requirements of subsection (a) has a supply of unissued student identification cards that do not  
11 comply with the requirement in subsection (a), the school shall issue those student identification  
12 cards to students until that supply is depleted.

13 (c) Subsection (a) shall apply to a student identification card issued to a new student and  
14 to a student identification card issued to replace a student's damaged or lost student identification  
15 card at the request of that student.

16 SECTION 2. Chapter 73 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
17 section 20 the following section:-

18 Section 21. (a) Commencing August 1, 2022, a public or private institution of higher  
19 education that issues student identification cards shall include on the student identification cards  
20 the telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, Crisis Text Line, and the  
21 school's campus police or security telephone number or, if the school does not have a campus  
22 police or security telephone number, the local nonemergency telephone number.

23 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if, as of August 1, 2023, a state university or  
24 community college subject to the requirements of subsection (a) has a supply of unissued student  
25 identification cards that do not comply with the requirement in subsection (a), the school shall  
26 issue those student identification cards to students until that supply is depleted.

27 (c) Subsection (a) shall apply for a student identification card issued to a new student and  
28 for a student identification card issued to replace a student's damaged or lost student  
29 identification card at the request of that student.
