An Act authorizing the investment of trust funds benefiting the town of Sherborn library.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 54 of chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, the treasurer of the town of Sherborn and the treasurer of  
3 the town of Sherborn library trustees may invest any trust funds benefiting the Sherborn library  
4 in accordance with the prudent investor rule and with chapter 203C of the General Laws.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
