An Act relative to school immunization requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The first sentence of Section 15 of Chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 deleting the words “and poliomyelitis and such other communicable diseases as may be specified  
3 from time to time by the department of public health” and inserting, after the word “measles”,  
4 the following words “, mumps, rubella, poliomyelitis, haemophilus influenzae type B, hepatitis  
5 B, varicella and meningitis, with required dosages of each immunization for each age group  
6 specified in regulations promulgated by the department of public health following a public  
7 hearing in accordance with the requirements of Section 2 of Chapter 30A.”.
