**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the certification of resident care assistants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 71C the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 71D: Nurse Aide Training

4 Nurses aides or Resident Care Assistants that were hired during the public health  
5 emergency established on March 11, 2020 shall forego the requirement of completing the state  
6 approved Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) training program if they have met one of the following  
7 criteria:

8 (1) The nurse aide or Resident Care Assistant successfully completed an online  
9 asynchronous CNA training program and competency assessment; or

10 (2) The nurse aide or Resident Care Assistant completed a minimum of 80 hours of nurse  
11 aide or supervised practical nurse aide training, on-the-job training or regular in-service nurse

12 aide education during the COVID-19 public health emergency under the supervision of a  
13 licensed or registered nurse.

14           The nurse aides shall be required to successfully pass the state CNA certification exam to  
15 be deemed a certified nurse aide.
