In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act for community housing packages.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The Massachusetts General Laws are hereby amended by inserting the
- 2 following new chapter:
- 3 An Act for Community Housing Packages.
- 4 PURPOSE OF THIS ACT:
- 5 Over a period of many recent years, it has been concluded by many communities,
- 6 especially in Eastern Massachusetts, that the supply of affordable, high-quality, and/or housing
- 7 of almost any kind, has fallen short of the actual needs, thereby creating severe economic
- 8 pressures, often for, both employees, and employers, in convenience to actual work places.

9	Only by, creating improved incentives, and distinct standards, might these problems be
10	eased, to the extent that it is possible, and these matters, are the business, and purpose of this act.
11	1.) The Department of Communities and Development, shall be authorized to create, after
12	due consideration, Community Housing Packages (CHPs), for helping to create, and
13	recruit,
14	improved economics, across the 351 municipalities of Massachusetts, to expand, and
15	strengthen
16	local communities, and especially affordable, safe, and durable housing units. These
17	CHPs, shall
18	be part of a comprehensive state planning, and coordination process, intersecting with
19	Master
20	Planning processes, as needed, and appropriate.
21	2.) The Department of Communities and Development, shall be authorized to create
22	suitable
23	Regulations, to provide for the provisions of this statute, taking into account, particular
24	local
25	preferences for, and including strengthened, safe, and durable housing units; that reflect
26	state-of-
27	the-art, fire-resistant, and energy-efficient standards.

28	3.) Such Community Housing Packages shall be based on encouraging, where possible,
29	mixed-use development, and by consulting a recognized list of pre-screened,
30	neighborhood, and
31	community-friendly developers, and contractors, with high-quality lasting construction
32	standards.
33	4.) The Department of Housing and Community Development, shall establish, keep, and
34	annually renew, a listing of high-quality, neighborhood, and community-friendly
35	developers, by
36	welcoming, pre-screening, of such companies, interviewing them, and publicizing such
37	businesses, in various appropriate positive publicity, by public announcement, and
38	general
39	media.
40	5.) Community Housing Packages (CHPs), shall take into account relevant modest, to
41	medium
42	intensity regional transit options, in helping newer local economic development; and
43	intersect
44	with state transportation planning.
