Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 93H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following

- 4 "Biometric indicator", any unique biological attribute or measurement that can be used to
- 5 authenticate the identity of an individual, including but not limited to fingerprints, genetic
- 6 information, iris or retina patterns, voice recognition, facial characteristics or hand geometry.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 93H of the General Laws is hereby further amended by
- 8 striking out, in line 45, the word "or".

- 9 SECTION 3. Section 1 of chapter 93H of the General Laws is hereby further amended by
 10 inserting after the word "public" in line 52, the following words:-
