An Act to extend veterans retirement buyback opportunities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The first sentence of the fourth paragraph of subsection (h) of section 4 of  
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words “four years  
3 provided” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 10 years; provided.

4           SECTION 2. The third sentence of the fourth paragraph of subsection (h) of section 4 of  
5 chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the words “five years guard  
6 service or five years active reserve service” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- 4  
7 years guard service or 4 years active reserve service.
