**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act to ensure pension parity for County Jail and Lockup employees..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 3 paragraph g of subdivision 2 the following:-

3 Notwithstanding paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the  
4 General Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, in addition to the sheriff;  
5 special sheriff, superintendents, assistant superintendents, assistant deputy superintendents and  
6 booking, evidence and transport supervisors and officers of the Dukes County sheriff’s  
7 department jail facility or Dukes County sheriff’s department lockup facility shall be classified in  
8 Group 4 for the purposes of chapter 32, in parity with other County correctional facility  
9 employees..
