An Act relative to pension parity.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 90C <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the words “retired before” and inserting in place thereof the following:- “retired or  
3 eligible to have retired before”.

4           SECTION 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply only to former state or metropolitan  
5 district police officers living on the date of enactment.
