An Act relative to executive office of public safety and security dispatchers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the words "supervision of prisoners;", in line 272, the  
3 following:- "employees of the Executive Office of Public Safety and Security working as State  
4 Police Dispatchers or State 911 Dispatchers in groups SPD 1, 2, and 3 who have been employed  
5 in a such a capacity for 10 years or more;"
