**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court

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An Act relative to Massachusetts certified emergency telecommunicators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Amend Part I, Title IV, Chapter 32, Section 3, paragraph G, “Group 2” of the  
2 Massachusetts General Laws by inserting the following after the words “Cushing hospital”:-

3 All full-time dispatchers, dispatch supervisors, communications center directors or  
4 communications chiefs certified by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts State 911 Department  
5 as Certified Telecommunicators as defined by MA 560 CMR 5.04
