*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws subsection (g) is hereby
- 2 amended by including “drinking water operators licensed by the Board of Certification of
- 3 Drinking Water Supply Facilities pursuant to Chapter 112, Section 87CCCC.”
