**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the membership of the PRIM board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Edition, is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in lines 201 and 202, the words “a representative of a public safety
3 union who shall be appointed by the governor”, and inserting in place thereof the following:- “a
4 public safety union member who shall be appointed by the governor from a list of three such
5 nominees submitted by the Massachusetts Association of Contributory Retirement Systems
6 Elected Executive Board”.
