An Act relative to public higher education campus police officers injured in the line of duty.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 111F of Chapter 41 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 22, after the word “airport,” the  
3   following words:- any campus police officer employed by a state university, college or  
4   community college.
