*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 58 of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,  
2           is hereby amended by inserting, in line 19, after the word “custody,” the following words:- or  
3           receives bodily injuries from acts of violence by a civilian present on the grounds of a  
4           correctional institution or state public health or human services facility;
