By Mr. Rush, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1775) of Michael F. Rush, Alan Silvia, Steven S. Howitt and Paul A. Schmid, III for legislation relative to disability retirees and restoration to service. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to disability retirees and restoration to service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 1.Paragraph (a) of Subdivision (1) of Section 8 of Chapter 32 is hereby amended
2	by striking in line 6 and line 9 the phrase "the same department" and inserting in place thereof :
3	"a retirement system".
4	Said section is further amended by adding after the word "job" in line 25: "or similar
5	position".
6	Said section is further amended by striking in line 63 the phrase "the same department"
7	and inserting in place thereof: "a retirement system"
8	Said section is further amended by inserting the following new paragraph after the first
9	paragraph:
10	During the regular periodic review process done pursuant to this section a member may
11	request that, in addition to being evaluated for a return to his former position, he be evaluated for

12 a specific identified position other than the position from which he retired. Said evaluation will 13 be conducted in the same manner as all other examinations provided for in this section. If the 14 member is found able to perform the essential duties of the identified position he shall be 15 permitted to return to active service in said position and his pension provided for in section six or 16 seven shall cease upon his return to service.

Section 2. Paragraph (b) of Subdivision (2) of Section 8 of Chapter 32 is hereby amended
by adding the following sentences:

19 If the member returns to service, within a different retirement system than that from 20 which they retired, the original system will provide creditable service for any period of disability 21 prior to reinstatement to service in the new system; provided that if the member is subsequently 22 retired for a disability as a result of the injury for which such member was previously retired, the 23 original retirement system will be assessed a portion of the disability pension pursuant to the 24 provisions of subdivision (5) of section seven.
