**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to creditable service for Lisa Emma, a member of the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary Lisa M. Emma shall receive
- 2 3.2 years of creditable service under the Massachusetts Teachers' Retirement System to cover the
- 3 period of full time employment from August 2006 to November 2006.
