## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to creditable service for school business administrators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Subdivision (1) of section 4 of Chapter 32 is hereby amended by inserting

2 after paragraph (h1/2) the following paragraph:-

| 3  | Any member in service of the teachers' retirement system who is employed as a school            |

| 4  | business administrator may receive creditable service for any period or periods of prior        |
| 5  | occupational experience which was required as a condition of the member's licensure as a school |
| 6  | business administrator by the office of elementary and secondary education. No credit shall be  |
| 7  | allowed until the member has paid into the Annuity Savings Fund of the system before any        |
| 8  | retirement allowance becomes effective for the member, in 1 sum, or in installments, upon the   |
| 9  | terms and conditions as the board may prescribe, makeup payments of an amount equal to          |
| 10 | seventeen percent of the current salary of such member for each year of service purchased. No   |

- 11 credit shall be allowed and no payment shall be accepted under this paragraph until the member
- 12 has completed 10 or more years of membership service. No credit shall be allowed if the member
- 13 has already received or is otherwise eligible to receive creditable service for any period or
- 14 periods of prior occupational work experience under Chapter 32. The creditable service
- 15 allowable under this paragraph for any member shall not exceed 3 years.
