An Act relative to correct inequities regarding the retirement of state-employed and special authority-employed police officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 253, the words "University of Massachusetts police".

SECTION 2. Section 3 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out the words "chief of security for the University of Massachusetts medical school of supervising agent", in lines 322 through 324, and inserting in place thereof the following words:"University of Massachusetts, Massport police, and state university and community college police."
