In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act reducing the costs for adoption.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-
- 3 (n) There is hereby established a credit for licensed Massachusetts attorneys who provide
- 4 pro bono legal services in at least one adoption per year. Each adoption case shall entitle said
- 5 attorney to a \$500 credit and shall be limited to no more than \$2,500 in each taxable year.
