An Act establishing a tax credit for teachers purchasing supplies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (a) of part B of section 3 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following  
3 subparagraph:-

4 (16) An amount as described in section 62(a)(2)(D) of the Code for certain expenses of  
5 elementary and secondary school teachers, only to the extent the amount is not otherwise  
6 deducted under subparagraph (7).

7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall be effective for tax years beginning on or after January 1,  
8 2022.
