In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act providing municipal control of liquor licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section
- 2 17 and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 Section 17. The legislative body of each city or town that has voted to grant licenses for
- 4 the sale of alcoholic beverages as provided in section 11 shall determine the number of licenses
- 5 issued in the city or town under section 12 or 15. Cities or towns that have voted to grant licenses
- 6 as provided in section 11 may grant seasonal licenses under section 12 in a number determined
- by the legislative body. Cities or towns that have voted to grant licenses as provided in section 11
- 8 may grant licenses under sections 12, 15 or 15F to the holder of a farmer-winery license under
- 9 section 19B in a number determined by the legislative body.

- SECTION 2. Sections 17A, 7B and 17C of said chapter 138 are hereby repealed.
- SECTION 3. The number of licenses for the sale of alcoholic beverages allowed by prior
- law shall continue in force until changed by the legislative body under section 17 of chapter 138.
