An Act relative to funding of the Massachusetts State House police memorial.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 35LLL the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 35MMM. There shall be established and set up on the books of the  
4 Commonwealth a separate fund to be known as the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial  
5 Fund to be used without appropriation by a department of public safety for the purpose of  
6 making annual payments to the Massachusetts Law Enforcement Memorial to memorialize and  
7 honor Massachusetts law enforcement personnel killed in the line of duty. There shall be credited  
8 to the fund revenues received by the Commonwealth from the sale of registration plates under  
9 section 2G of chapter 90.
