Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8B of Chapter 81 of the General laws, is hereby amended by striking the third
- 2 paragraph and replacing it with the following:-

- 4 public record as defined by Section 7 of Chapter 4 except that financial information contained in
- 5 the application shall not be a public record.".
