An Act to eliminate geographic barriers of shared solar.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 75 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3           (d) For any solar incentive program developed pursuant to this section, customers of any  
4 distribution company located in the commonwealth shall be designated to receive such credits,  
5 including alternative on bill credits, in amounts attributed by the solar tariff generation units.
