## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act protecting broadband access in the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 124F of Chapter 164 of the general laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following new paragraph:-
- No broadband company, as defined in section 6B, chapter 40J of the general laws, shall
- 4 between September first and June thirtieth shut off broadband service to any residential customer
- 5 who cannot pay an overdue charge because of financial hardship, when broadband service is
- 6 used to provide internet access and wireless internet access. The department may promulgate
- 7 such rules and regulations consistent with this section as it deems reasonable and necessary to
- 8 implement the provision of this section.
