*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 94A of chapter 164 of the General Laws is amended by inserting, at the end

2 thereof, the following paragraph:-

| 3 | The department shall not approve any pipeline capacity contract or gas storage contract             |

| 4 | where new capacity is proposed to be created through the installation of gas infrastructure in land |
| 5 | that, at the time the contract is submitted to the department for approval, is protected under      |

| 7 | siting approvals of gas infrastructure in such constitutionally protected land shall void           |
| 8 | departmental approval of related pipeline capacity or gas storage contracts.                        |
