An Act relative to requiring notification of hazardous utility work to local and regional emergency departments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, utility companies shall be
- 2   required to notify both local and regional police, fire, emergency and all other related public
- 3   works departments of any hazardous public work projects conducted by that utility company or
- 4   an independent contractor within their jurisdiction.
