Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The first sentence of section 18 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by

- inserting after the word "control" the following words:-; and provided further, that in setting a
- 3 speed regulation, the city council, the transportation commission of the city of Boston, the board
- 4 of selectmen, park commissioners, or the traffic commission or traffic director of a city or town
- 5 may reduce the limit determined as reasonable and proper by the department by 5 miles per hour.
