adding, after paragraph (c) the following paragraph:-

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 13 of Chapter 6C of the General Laws is hereby amended by 2
- 3 "(d) Information on tolls, including, where applicable, toll usage, tolls due, balance, late
- 4 and other fees, fines, penalties, and other amounts due associated with toll or other transactions,
- 5 as well as payment options, shall be made available through an online database that is searchable
- 6 by both (i) vehicle registration number, and (ii) date of toll assessment, within one business day
- 7 of the toll being assessed. Information for accessing the online database shall be printed on a sign
- 8 visible to the driver at the point where the toll is assessed. No invoice issued by the department
- 9 to a vehicle's registered owner of record or responsible party for purposes of collecting tolls shall
- 10 be mailed fewer than 7 days after the assessment of the toll."
