In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to distinctive plates for veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. The fifteenth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 411, after the
- 3 word "furnish" the following words:- "without charge".
- 4 SECTION 2. Said fifteenth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90, as so appearing, is

5 hereby further amended by striking the third sentence.

- 6 SECTION 3. Said section 2 of chapter 90, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by
- 7 inserting the following:-
- 8 "Notwithstanding any provision of this section, no veteran, who is the owner of a private
- 9 passenger motor vehicle or a motorcycle, shall be charged an annual fee for a distinctive
- 10 registration plate."
