An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Needham the private first class David “Damon” Borrelli memorial bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The Great Plain Ave. Bridge No. N-04-011, in the Town of Needham, shall be designated  
2   and known as the Private First Class David “Damon” Borrelli Memorial Bridge in recognition of  
3   David Borrelli. Private First Class David Borrelli was killed in action on eleven July 1941 in  
4   France. Serving in the United States Army, A Company, 1st Battalion, 116th Infantry Regiment,  
5   David was in the initial invasion on Omaha Beach in Normandy, France. David was killed at the  
6   age of twenty-one in the Battle of Saint-Lô, a crossroads town in Normandy that was reduced to  
7   rubble. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable  
8   marker bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
