In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to protecting residents from hazardous traffic conditions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21C is hereby amended by inserting after section 12 the following section:-
- 2 Section 13. No facility governed by section 150A or 150A1/2 of chapter 111 shall be
- 3 constructed unless said facility is constructed in a municipality that has direct access to a road
- 4 designated as an expressway by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, and no
- 5 building permit shall be issued for such a facility unless the applicant has demonstrated such
- 6 direct access.
