An Act relative to protecting residents from hazardous traffic conditions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 21C is hereby amended by inserting after section 12 the following section:-

2 Section 13. No facility governed by section 150A or 150A1/2 of chapter 111 shall be  
3 constructed unless said facility is constructed in a municipality that has direct access to a road  
4 designated as an expressway by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, and no  
5 building permit shall be issued for such a facility unless the applicant has demonstrated such  
6 direct access.
