Senate, September 13, 2021 -- Offered by Senator Spilka relative to setting the date for a special election to fill the vacancy in the First Suffolk and Middlesex senatorial district.

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

1 *Ordered*, That by the authority of Article IV of Section II of Chapter I of the
2 Constitution, the Senate declares that, by reason of the resignation of Joseph A. Boncore as
3 Senator from the First Suffolk and Middlesex district, the office of senator from the First Suffolk
4 and Middlesex district is vacant. By the authority of Article XXIV of the Amendments to the
5 Constitution, the Senate directs the president of the Senate to issue a precept setting forth January
6 11, 2022, as the day for holding an election to fill the vacancy in the First Suffolk and Middlesex
7 district, comprising of the cities of Boston, ward 1, precincts 1 to 14, inclusive, ward 3, precincts
8 1 to 4, inclusive, 6 and 8, and ward 5, precinct 1, 3 to 5, inclusive, and 11, Revere and the town
9 of Winthrop, all in the county of Suffolk; and the city of Cambridge, ward 2, precincts 2 and 3,
10 ward 4, precincts 1 and 3, and ward 5, all in the county of Middlesex.
