An Act relative to required minimum limits for damage to personal property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 113B1/2 of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
2 hereby amended by striking the figure "\$5,000" as it appears in lines 3 and 11 and replacing it  
3 with the following figure:- "\$20,000".

4           SECTION 2. This act shall go into effect upon its passage.
