An Act exempting the town of Brookline from in-person quorums.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The town of Brookline shall be exempt from the provision of chapter 30A,  
2   section 20(d), that requires that a quorum of the body, including the chair, be present at an in-  
3   person meeting location (specifically, from “and provided, further, that a quorum of the body,  
4   including the chair, are present at the meeting location”).

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
