An Act relative to early education funding.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 64 of chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following words:- ; and provided further, that 32.5 per cent of  
3 the funds shall be appropriated for the purposes of early education to supplement, not offset, any  
4 reduction in the general appropriation act from previous fiscal year.
