In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act authorizing the town of Avon to grant one additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
- 2 licensing authority of the town of Avon may, upon receipt of a completed application, payment
- 3 of any applicable fees, after a public hearing and all due process, and in its sole discretion grant
- 4 one (1) additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be consumed on the
- 5 premises, under Section 12 of said Chapter 138 to Wine.com, 33 Wales Avenue, Avon, MA: said
- 6 license to be subject to said Chapter 138, except Section 17.
- 7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
