An Act amending the town charter of Ipswich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 6 of chapter 620 of the acts of 1966 as amended by chapter 152 of the acts of
- 2 2019 is hereby amended by striking the section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following:-
- 4 "SECTION 6. The Select Board shall appoint a town manager for a term of three (3)
- 5 years. The town manager shall be appointed without regard to the town manager's political
- 6 beliefs. The Select Board may reappoint an incumbent town manager for successive, three-year
- 7 terms of office, as the board may determine to be in the best interests of the Town. Before
- 8 entering upon the duties of the office, the town manager shall be sworn to the faithful and
- 9 impartial performance thereof by the chairman of the Select Board, the town clerk or a justice of
- the peace. The town manager shall execute a bond in favor of the town for the faithful
- performance of the town manager's duties in such sum and with such surety or sureties as may be
- 12 fixed or approved by the Select Board."
