An Act relative to media literacy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1P of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by inserting, in line 9, after the words “other similar initiatives” the following  
3   new language:- “and the development of skills to access, analyze and evaluate written and digital  
4   media as it relates to physical and emotional health, including but not limited to how media  
5   affects physical and emotional health, social relationships, and body-image”.
