1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 330 of the acts of 1981, section 3 of chapter 40 of
2	the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the city of Newton may
3	lease a certain parcel of land located at 1135 to 1137 Washington street for not more than 99
4	years for affordable housing purposes, subject to any necessary affordability restrictions set forth
5	in chapter 157 of the acts of 2020. The parcel was acquired by the city of Newton pursuant to
6	said chapter 157 by a deed recorded in the Middlesex southern district registry of deeds in book
7	78642, page 6.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
