An Act relative to pension parity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 14 or section 18 of chapter 176 of
2	the Acts of 2011, or any general or special law to the contrary, the state retirement board shall re-
3	calculate, as of the effective date of his retirement, the retirement allowance of Francis J. Doyle,
4	a member of the state employees retirement system. This act shall not affect any other retirement
5	benefits to which Francis J. Doyle may otherwise be entitled. The state retirement board may
6	take any appropriate steps required to complete the re-calculation.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
