

SENATE No. 3179

Senate, January 3, 2023 -- Text of the Senate amendment (Rodrigues) to the Engrossed Bill relative to the South Boston Community Development Foundation (House, No. 5120).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (g) of section 4 of chapter 152 of the acts of 1997, as amended
2 by chapter 256 of the acts of 2006, is hereby further amended by striking out paragraph (i) and
3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-

4 (i) The South Boston Community Development Foundation, or foundation, shall consist
5 of a committee of 13 members: 3 members appointed by the governor who shall be business
6 owners from the locally-impacted neighborhood; 3 members appointed by the mayor who shall
7 be representatives of local social service agencies; the senator from the first Suffolk district or a
8 designee, who shall be a non-voting member; the representative from the fourth Suffolk, who
9 shall be a non-voting member; 2 members appointed by the senator from the first Suffolk
10 district, 1 of whom shall be a veteran or active duty service member; 2 members appointed by
11 the representative from the fourth Suffolk district, 1 of whom shall a member of the local
12 hospitality workforce; and the Boston city councilor from district 2, or a designee; all of whom,
13 with the exception of the elected officials, shall be residents of the South Boston section of the
14 city of Boston, and shall serve a 2-year term which may be extended by reappointment.

15 The South Boston Community Development Fund shall consist of monies held in a
16 Massachusetts Charitable Trust to be placed in a money market interest-bearing account to be
17 administered by the South Boston Community Development Foundation.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
