Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Subsection (a) of section 7A of chapter 55 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (3) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:-
- 3 (3) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any political 4 committee not specified in paragraph (1), (2), (4) or (5); provided, however, that the aggregate of 5 such campaign contributions to any single such political committee shall not exceed \$500 in any 6 calendar year.
- 7 SECTION 2: Said subsection (a) of said section 7A of said chapter 55 is hereby further 8 amended by adding the following paragraph:-
  - (5) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any independent expenditure PAC as defined in section 18A; provided, however, that the aggregate of campaign
