Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 58 of chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting the following words after "thereof.":-
- 3 "Provided further that any persons hunting migratory game birds from a watercraft or any
- 4 boat or floating device propelled by sail, steam, naphtha, gasoline, electricity, compressed air or
- 5 similar motive power, shall not discharge any firearm within one thousand feet of the coastal
- 6 shoreline."
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 65 of chapter 131 of the General Law is hereby amended by
- 8 inserting the following words after "blind":- ", provided further that any water craft used for said
- 9 hunting purposes shall not be within one thousand feet of the coastal shoreline;"
