**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court

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An Act relative to the pesticide board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 3 of chapter 132B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking paragraph 5 and inserting in place thereof, the following  
3 paragraph:-

4 The board, in addition to other powers conferred in this chapter, shall advise the  
5 commissioner of food and agriculture with respect to the implementation and administration of  
6 this chapter. The commissioner of food and agriculture shall consult and concur with the  
7 commissioner of environmental protection and commissioner of public health when rendering a  
8 decision under section 13 of this chapter, relative to the protection of groundwater sources of  
9 drinking water from pesticide contamination.
